Overview of Curriculum

- ♦ Nursery to Upper KG: Cambridge Early Years Program
- ♦ Grade 1 to 5: Students choose either the CBSE or the Cambridge Primary Years.
- ♦ Grade 6 to 8: Students choose either the CBSE or the Cambridge Lower Secondary.
- ♦ Grade 9 to 10: Students choose either the CBSE or the Cambridge IGCSE.
- ♦ Grade 11 to 12: Students choose either the CBSE or the Cambridge AS / A Level.

* **We introduced Cambridge AS/A Level curriculum in 2022-23 and our first batch will graduate in 2024**

AP Courses Taught in School

The school offers the teaching of AP subjects such as Calculus AB, English Language & Composition, English Literature & Composition, Computer Science A, and Pre-Calculus.

Besides these subjects students can self-study and take the AP external examinations in the school.

Ranking

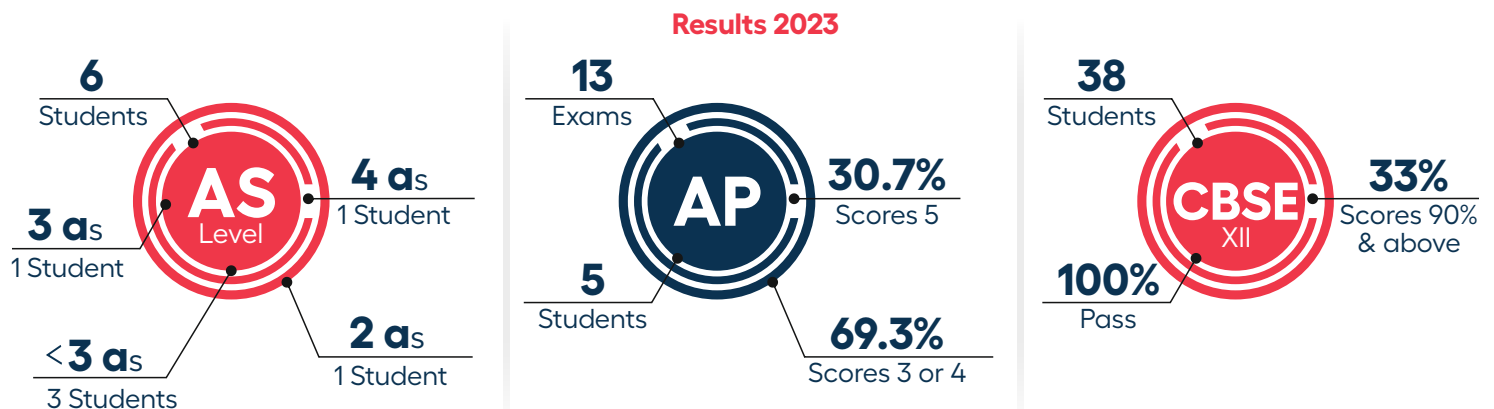
We do not rank our students on basis of their academic performance.
